3 MAJOR SIGNS OF AN OVERDOSE



Very slow, irregular,
or no breathing



Blue, purple, or gray
lips and fingernails



Unresponsiveness to
pain (breastbone rub)

Other signs include: Tiny pupils, choking sounds, or a snor-like gurgling noise.



You Never Know

Fake pills are made to look like many different types of prescription pills, such as:

- oxycodone (Oxycontin® Percocet®)
- hydrocodone (Vicodin®)
- alprazolam (Xanax®)
- other stimulants like amphetamines (Adderall®)
