Which Is For Me? New Ways to Prevent RSV

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) causes cold symptoms in Fall/Winter, but can cause severe illness in babies, older adults, and those with some medical conditions





In <u>studies</u>, nirsevimab prevented hospitalizations and severe illness from RSV





RSV cases are on the rise! Check out if you are eligible for newly available medications to prevent severe RSV



It reduced risk of severe RSV in babies after birth.

Older Adults

Arexvy and Abrysvo are two newly



approved RSV vaccines.



Both vaccines <u>effectively prevented</u> severe RSV for two seasons in older adults

Adults \geq 60 years, especially those with medical conditions, can get one of these vaccines
